Approval of Minutes for July 8, 2021

Advisory appointment terms for current members

Erik reviewed draft Resolution # 21-003 that renews the appointment terms for 6 current members of the Chehalis River Basin FCZD Advisory Committee.

Bonnie Coumbs, David Fenn, Steven Grega have three (3) year terms that expired on August 13, 2021 and Bill Brumsickle, Charles Coddington and John Henricksen have two (2) year terms that expired on August 28, 2021.

Dave, Steven, Bill and John all agreed to have their appointments renewed. Bonnie and Chuck were absent and Lara will get in touch with them to see if they would like their appointment renewed.

2021 Budget Amendment review

Erik reviewed the draft budget amendment which adds \$650k to various line items in the budget.

The Notice as published reflected an increase in expenditures of \$650,000 and in increase of revenue of \$650,000 for the Chehalis Basin Strategy work. The Office of the Chehalis Basin Board met on August 16 and passed the 2021-2023 biennium budget and spending plan for the Chehalis Basin Strategy.

The total 2021 amended budget will be \$2,265,450 for revenues and \$2,265,450 for expenditures.

Frank made a motion to recommend the budget amendment in the amount of \$650,000 for revenues and expenditures be moved forward to the district supervisors for approval. Bill seconded the motion.

Motion approved.

CFHMP update

Erik noted there was a Public Open House held on September 1 which is a required part of the process to adopt the Comprehensive Flood Hazard Management Plan (CFHMP).

The public comment period ends September 30th and the comments will be addressed and then approved by the supervisors.

Erik said the CFHMP is intended to be a guiding document for the district to know the goals, mission and actions it may able to take to best serve the citizens in Lewis County. It also meets a checkbox on the CRS program which determines the flood insurance rates.

Social media and communications update

Erik discussed the work HDR has been doing and encouraged everyone to go on Facebook and follow the flood district page.

He also discussed the fact sheet that HDR has developed which will be finalized soon.

The group discussed the comments on social media regarding the new Honda dealership. Erik noted he will talk with the City of Chehalis about messaging.

Project update

Erik noted we are kicking off the next phase and the district submitted a list of commitments in early September to the Dept. of Ecology and Army Corps of Engineers. It is a list of items that the district committed to do. One of the items on the list is no net loss of habitat and committing to it.
